Ticketing & Athletic Event Management Plan - Winter 2020-21

- These restrictions apply to both middle school and high school SWBL athletic events.
- These restrictions apply to basketball and wrestling outlined below.
- Tickets are not available to the general public, only to athletes' families.
- Everyone, besides administration and support staff, must buy a ticket.
- SWBL Lifetime Passes and local senior citizen passes will not be accepted.
- SWBL Passes will NOT be distributed to member schools and will not be accepted.
- Families and close contacts are encouraged to travel, enter and exit the venue together
- Families are required to sit together.
- Everyone will sit with their family/close contacts. No student sections of any kind.
- Children under two years of age will not need a ticket and need to stay with their parents at all times.
- Media and college coaches are welcome and will not count in either team's total fans.
- Spectators will not be allowed into the facility early.
- After the varsity game, the building will be cleared immediately, everyone will need to head to their cars. If families need to wait for their kids, they will need to do so in the parking lot and not in the building.
- Water will not be provided. Each athlete should bring their own.
- Student sections will not be allowed. Everyone will need to sit with their family/close contacts.
- Standing will not be permitted. Everyone will need to sit with their family/close contacts.
- JV Players are encouraged to ride home with their parents immediately after the JV game.
- Masks will be required at all times, including when sitting in bleachers with family/close contact.
 - Coaches and support staff must wear a mask at all times.
 - Masks should be worn by all players whenever they are not in the game or warming up.
- Tickets
 - Ticket availability will be determined by the venue based on capacity.
 - Some venues will only be able to accommodate one ticket per athlete
 - Each player is allotted a set number of tickets.
 - Schools can handle home tickets however they want.
- Game Management
 - Both teams should arrive fully dressed.
 - Locker rooms will be provided for brief team meetings before and after the game as well as half time. Locker rooms should not be used for congregation.
