

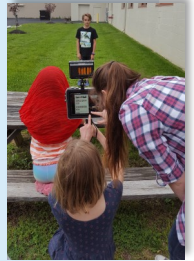

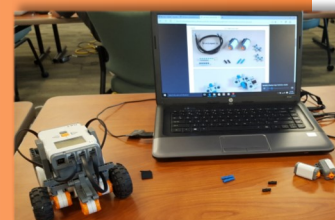


LEGO MINDSTORM CAMP
