FRANKLIN, OH - On Thursday 1/25/18, the Franklin High School Administration conducted a thorough investigation of the alleged threat made by a student on Wednesday, 1/24/18. At the conclusion of that investigation, the administration did find reasonable cause to discipline a FHS student for making threats and inducing panic. Appropriate school discipline has been levied. In addition, the information collected through our investigation will be given to the Franklin Police Department to determine if criminal charges are warranted. As stated in the first press release, the student in question was not in attendance today, and at no time was the safety of FHS students in question.

Student safety is the top priority of both Franklin High School and Franklin City Schools. We feel certain that with today's actions, all students will continue to have a safe environment in which to learn. We encourage our students, parents, and staff to report anything they hear or see that may seem threatening. We would like to thank the individual that alerted the administration of this threat that allowed us to begin this very important investigation.
