At approximately 8:38 a.m. today, a bomb threat was received via phone call for the Franklin High School/Franklin Junior High School campus at 750 East Fourth Street.

All students and staff were evacuated in an orderly fashion. Everyone was safe and quickly accounted for. The Butler County Sheriff's bomb squad searched the campus and determined that no bomb or safety threat was present.

We appreciate the exemplary behavior of our students and the professionalism of our staff and their adherence to the safety protocols for this situation. We are thankful to the personnel of the Franklin Police Department, Springboro Police Department and Butler County Sheriff Department who were on site and assisted with the incident.

Students were cleared to return to their buildings at approximately 10:30 a.m.

Authorities are investigating the source of the threat.
